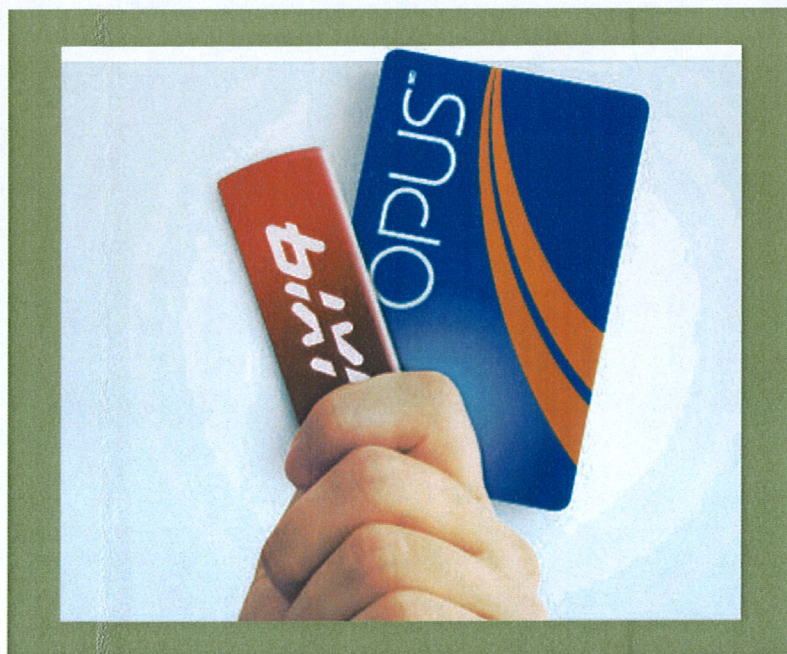

ARE YOU BIXI-ING YET?

By now you've surely heard or seen about the Bixi bike craze in Montreal. While living at Le 6000 gives you quick access to downtown Montreal, the greater Plateau, and Mont Royal, riding a bixi can get you there even faster. The city of Montreal decided to implement the bixi bike system in its transportation plan "Reinventer Montreal." Since Montreal blends its North American culture with European flair, it was thought that bixi bikes would catch on with ease, having already succeeded in breaking into the European market. The Montreal transportation system views Bixi as a complement, not a replacement, for the existing public transportation (such as the metro and bus).
