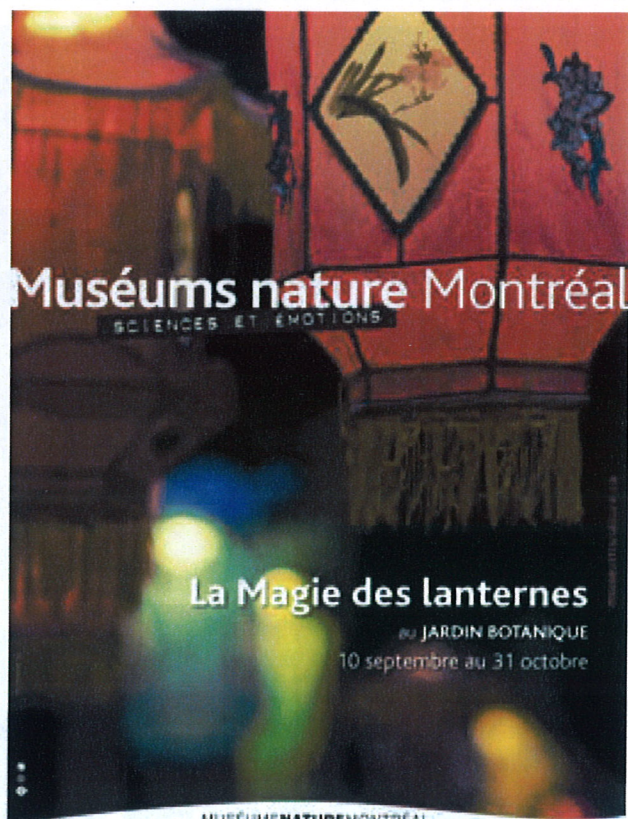

- Average September temperature: 15.6°C / 60°F
- September average high: 20.6°C / 69°F
- September average low: 9°C / 48°F
- Rain average 7 - 9 days this month

In terms of clothing, plan to leave the house wearing layers. September weather is unpredictable, so make sure to have a sweater or jacket just in case temperatures drop. Wear closed-toed shoes in order to be comfortable walking the city to see the incredible fall foliage!

THE MAGIC OF LANTERNS (Chinese Garden, Montréal Botanical Garden)

This year the Montreal Botanical Gardens celebrates the 18th edition of The Magic of Lanterns, from **September 10 to October 31, 2010** at the Chinese Garden (see address below). This year's theme is *Like a Painting*, inspired by the Chinese painting *Qing Ming Shang He Tu*. In China the Lantern Festival is a tradition that goes back to the Han dynasty (206 B.C.-220 A.D.). The Montreal Botanical Gardens honour this tradition by offering a dazzling array of thematic lanterns, including over 700 traditional lanterns. In addition, visitors are encouraged to taste the green tea and pastries on sight.
