PICKING THE PERFECT HALLOWEEN PUMPKIN

Nothing says Halloween like a jack-o-lantern. For adults and children alike carving the seasonal gourd brings enjoyment. Even without carvings, pumpkins make phenomenal decorative additions to any home. So how can you ensure you chose the right pumpkin this Halloween?

• First, if you intend to carve your pumpkin (time for your lobotomy jack!), select a medium to large-sized one. You'll need ample space to stencil and carve! In addition, a smoother surfaced pumpkin means more precision in your design.

- Mixing and matching tall, narrow, large and small pumpkins make a great fall arrangement. Smaller pumpkins can be placed in a windowsill for visibility from the street!
- Finally, avoid carrying your carefully chosen pumpkin by the stem, as it could break.
